Our council member, Thomas Lee, on behalf of the Society of Construction Law Hong Kong, cordially invites you to an evening seminar to be held on Wednesday 23 January 2019 delivered by **Lee Baker** of **HKA** on **Building Virtually for Eternity** which will be held at the Hong Kong Club.

Lee will take a frank look at construction technology in particular BIM and digitalization. Lee will address the gathering and use of data on construction projects and the difficulties this can cause. He will explore some of the contractual issues around BIM that are likely to be faced in the near future and what construction professionals can do about it. Lee then then explore how we can use technology to communicate complex ideas and how this may be used by experts and counsel to assist courts and tribunals.

Lee is a delay analyst and Principal at HKA, responsible for the Forensic Delay Group in Asia. He has multiple appointments as an expert witness and has testified in the High Court of Singapore. Lee has nearly 15 years' industry experience and specialises in time-related matters and programme risk management. He has been appointed to prepare expert reports and regularly advises clients on dispute avoidance and resolution. Lee has extensive international experience of high value mega-projects, across a wide-range of industry sectors. These include Power Generation, Aviation, Rail, High-rise buildings; Oil & Gas; Prestige Retail; and Commercial developments. Lee's geographical experience includes projects located in: China, India, Indonesia, Malaysia, Mozambique, Qatar, Republic of Ireland, Russia, Singapore, South Africa, United Arab Emirates and United Kingdom. Lee was cited in Who's Who Legal: Construction 2017 as "Fantastic", and "widely regarded as one of the top construction experts in Singapore". In 2018, the same publication noted: "Lee Baker is one of the leading construction experts in the Singaporean market and is renowned for his excellent delay analysis in sector-related disputes".
